ORDINANCE

- **WHEREAS**, the City of Chicago ("City") is a home rule unit of government by virtue of the provisions of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970, and, as such, may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and
- WHEREAS, the City is the owner of the vacant parcel of real property commonly known as 5321 South Menard Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, and legally described on Exhibit A attached hereto (the "Property"); and
- WHEREAS, the City's Department of Aviation ("<u>CDA</u>") has determined that the Property, which was once needed decades ago by Midway Airport for an extended strip of runway approach lights, has no foreseeable or practical aviation use by the CDA; and
- **WHEREAS**, public notice advertising the RFP appeared in the *Chicago Sun-Times* on January 15, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, BPAC Building Company, LLC, an Illinois limited liability company (the "<u>Developer</u>" or "<u>Grantee</u>"), has timely submitted a proposal in response to the RFP, offering to purchase the Property for Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000), which amount is Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) more than the Property's current appraised fair market value of Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000), and to use the Property, subject to Developer's obtaining applicable zoning approvals, for a customer parking lot for a new restaurant Developer is opening across the street at 6021 South Archer Avenue; and
- WHEREAS, CDA determined that the Developer submitted a "complete and quality" proposal that satisfied the requirements of the RFP; and
- WHEREAS, no other proposals to the RFP have been received by the deadline indicated in the aforesaid notice; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City's conveyance of the Property is subject to the prior written approval of the Federal Aviation Administration; *now, therefore,*

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

- **SECTION 1.** The City Council, pursuant to the City's home rule authority, hereby approves the sale of the Property to the Developer for the amount of Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000).
- **SECTION 2.** Subject to the City's receipt of written approval from the Federal Aviation Administration to sell the Property, the Mayor or his proxy is authorized to execute, and the City Clerk or the Deputy City Clerk is authorized to attest, one or more quitclaim deeds conveying the Property to the Developer. Without limiting the quitclaim nature of such deed, such conveyance shall be subject to (i) standard exceptions in an ALTA insurance policy; (ii) general real estate taxes and any special assessments or other taxes; (iii) easements, encroachments, covenants, restrictions and liens of record and not shown of record; (iv) such other title defects as may exist; and (v) any and all exceptions caused by acts of the Grantee or its agents.

Such conveyance also shall be subject to the following conditions and covenants, in substantially the form set forth below, which are part of the consideration for the Property and

which are to be taken and construed as running with the land and binding on the Developer and its successors and assigns:

FIRST: The City of Chicago (the "City") makes no covenant, representation or warranty, express or implied, of any kind, as to the structural, physical or environmental condition of the Property or the suitability of the Property for any purpose whatsoever, and Grantee agrees to accept the Property in its "as is," "where is" and "with all faults" condition.

SECOND: Grantee shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, sex, gender identity, age, religion, disability, national origin, ancestry, sexual orientation, marital status, parental status, military discharge status, or source of income in the sale, lease, rental, use or occupancy of the Property or any part thereof.

THIRD: Grantee hereby waives and releases, and indemnifies the City from and against, any claims and liabilities relating to or arising from the structural, physical or environmental condition of the Property, including, without limitation, claims arising under the Comprehensive Environmental Response. Compensation and Liability Act of 1980, as amended ("CERCLA"), and shall undertake and discharge all liabilities of the City arising from any structural, physical or environmental condition that existed on the Property prior to the date of this deed, including, without limitation, liabilities arising under CERCLA. Grantee hereby acknowledges that, in purchasing the Property, Grantee is relying solely upon its own inspection and other due diligence activities and not upon any information (including, without limitation, environmental studies or reports of any kind) provided by or on behalf of the City or its agents or employees with respect thereto. If, after the date of this deed, the structural, physical and environmental condition of the Property is not in all respects entirely suitable for its intended use, it shall be Grantee's sole responsibility and obligation to take such action as is necessary to put the Property in a condition which is suitable for its intended use.

The covenants numbered FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD shall have no limitation as to time.

If Grantee fails to comply with any of the foregoing covenants and conditions, the City may exercise any and all remedies available to it at law or in equity.

- **SECTION 3.** The Commissioner and the Managing Deputy Commissioner of CDA are each authorized to execute any ancillary closing documents on behalf of the City.
- **SECTION 4.** If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.
- **SECTION 5.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
 - **SECTION 6.** This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
