BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:



In accordance with the requirements for an Amendment to the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, specifically Section 17-13-0107, please be informed that on or about August 31, 2020, the undersigned will file an application for a change in zoning from C1-2 Neighborhood Commercial District to B2-3 Neighborhood Mixed-Use District on behalf of TRP 2008-2012 Ashland, LLC, an Illinois limited liability company, for the property located at 2008-2012 South Ashland Avenue, Chicago, Illinois and described as follows:

A line 74.10 fect south of and parallel to the south line of West Cullerton Street; South Ashland Avenue; A line 146.10 feet south of and parallel to the south line of West Cullerton Street; the public alley next west of and parallel to South Ashland Avenue.

The purpose of the zoning amendment is to permit the applicant to develop a new four-story building with 14 dwelling units and not less than 5 parking spaces. The height of the building will not exceed 50 feet. There will be no commercial space in the building.
