2% DISABLED PARKING SIGN

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to establish and/or amend 2% Disabled Parking Signs at the below listed locations:

WARD	2% DISABLED PARKING SIGN:
27	West Superior Street (north side) from a point 20 feet west of North Sedgwick Street to a point 40 feet west thereof; All Times, All Days. [O2022-1206]
50	Amend Ordinance passed 6/25/2021, journal page 32052 which reads: North Whipple Street (east side) from a point 20 feet north West Peterson Avenue to a point 20 feet north thereof; Disabled Parking Permit, 5:30am to 5:30pm, Thursday and 5:30am to 2:00pm, Friday by striking the above and inserting No Parking (except for Handicapped) North Whipple Street (east side) from a point 20 feet north of West Peterson Avenue to a point 20 feet north thereof; 5:30am to 5:00pm Thursday and 5:30am to 2:00pm (public benefit) [Or2022-121]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.


